- Waxy Program
 - All corn is contract grown
 - Corn Grown from Iowa to Ohio
 - Premium 22 cents per bushel
 - Majority is grown in the Lafayette Area
 - Use two seed companies as a quality control
- Goal is traceability from the seed to our finished product

Sagamore Non Genetically Modified Corn

- Non GMO Program
 - All corn is contract grown with Producers
 - Corn Grown in Indiana and Illinois
 - Premium 10 cents per bushel
 - Specific Hybrid list to ensure traceability
 - HES??????
- Goal Is traceability from seed to finished Product

- **Rapid Pace of Genetic Modification**
 - Assurance that new events are properly marketed and channeled
 - No more StarLink disasters
 - Current Bt 10 issue
 - Improvement of base genetics
 - The technology is only as good as the base genetics
- **Waxy Conversions**
 - Shorter hybrid life cycles
 - Conversions completed near the end of the base life cycle
